



Transportation to/from Albuquerque International Sunport

The Albuquerque International Sunport (ABQ) is served by American Airlines, Delta Air Lines, Frontier Airlines, New Mexico Airlines, Northwest Airlines, Southwest Airlines, United Airlines, and US Airways. The airport is a quick 60 minute all-interstate drive from Santa Fe – the traffic is a continuous flow rather than stop-and-go on the interstate.

- Car rental customer service counters and ready/return lots are located at the Sunport Car Rental Center, 3400 University SE
- Car rental shuttles provide transportation between the terminal building and the Car Rental Center

- Shuttles run every 5 minutes from the commercial lane located outside the 1st level of the airport terminal building
- Shuttle buses are handicap-accessible
